

During his speech he gave 8 elements of life which he was able to figure out in his 30s, which are as follows:-

Spirituality

Mr yadav went on explaining every element with an example of events from his life, this gave the students a clear picture of his persona and his ideology, during his explanation of life and its elements we came to know that he is a Himalayan trekker, an avid cyclist, a tourism enthusiast and 2 Times guinness world record holder. He ended his speech by addressing the importance of one's contribution to society and why it's important to come out of comfort zone.

Later Amardeep Gurme sir gave the final words of program thanking the guest on behalf of Mr. Atul Kulkarni (principle) who was unavailable due to some reason followed by Smita ma'am s vote of thanks Which closed the event.

Professor Shiv Kumar introduced Mr. Rushikesh and his portfolio. Mr. Rushikesh is pursuing his bachelor's degree from MES Night College. And has more than (17) Seventeen Companies experience. Mr. Rushikesh started his session interactively asking student how many lives we have helped for throughout Environment needed for throughout session. Most of the students replied one and then Mr. Rushikesh requested think deeply about your answer. He asked followup question what you will do with this life? Students started thinking about the answer so he recommended student

to watch few videos about this topic. He asked another question why do honeybees deposit nectar more than 900% strength? Students tried to reply and then Mr. Rushikesh explained purpose of this process; Collecting Nectar and pollens from flowers is more important than producing Honey.

He asked students to find purpose of life / living and once you know purpose you will become passionate about it. Mr. Rushikesh mentioned that Dream Big. Dreams have No limits. Once start dreaming about your goal slowly will be achievable. He told one interesting story about Fisherman and another jogging person meaning of the story was Don't put boundary on yourselves

Then Mr. Rushikesh mentioned he has divided his life in (8) eight shelves

8. Spirituality (Donation of food at temple & Receiving smiling faces)

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Mr. Rushikesh has organised his days for all such activities (Hobbies, Work Schedule, learning new skills)

He shared past life experiences. He started with four start up during lock down. He mentioned break your comfort zone and situation make people change.

He gave two points.

- 1) pressure of threat
- 2) Motivation.

If you want to achieve the goal, you will find way forward and will not have excuses or complaints. He even gave an example [bus] job need. He said these are all his learning from his own experience and no one will tell you these in coming years. He also mentioned that he has his own Guinness world Records one of the records, was breaking under water chain in Italy. Mr. Rushikesh also mentioned that he has his own Guinness record because he believed (himself) also told Time is very Important and in organization is very important (self-realization). He said Target should be Customer not Manager. He mentioned about google skills/ platform for learning & development.



He said that time is also precious and told all students to visit a cafe order coffee/tea and keep aside the smartphone and think or let the different thoughts pop out. He mentioned he would like to beat honourable Mr. Ratan Tata in plantation drive.





Finally, the session covered the basics of trading, including order types and strategies for different risk profiles. It emphasized the importance of research, risk management, and goal setting before entering the market.

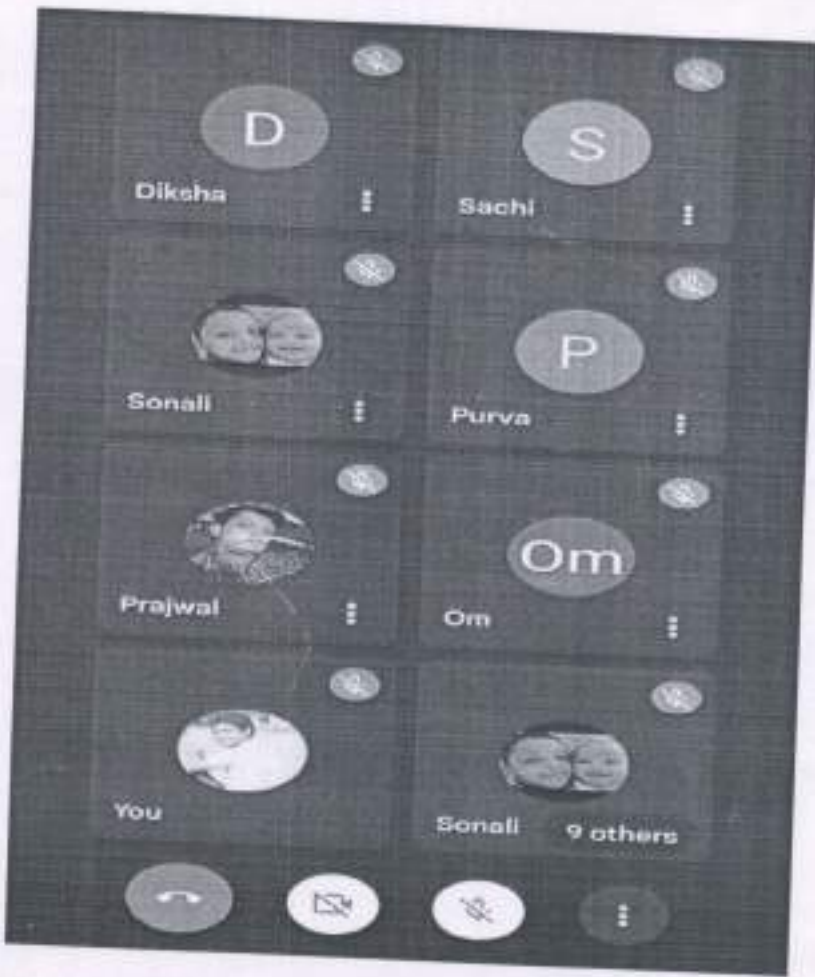
