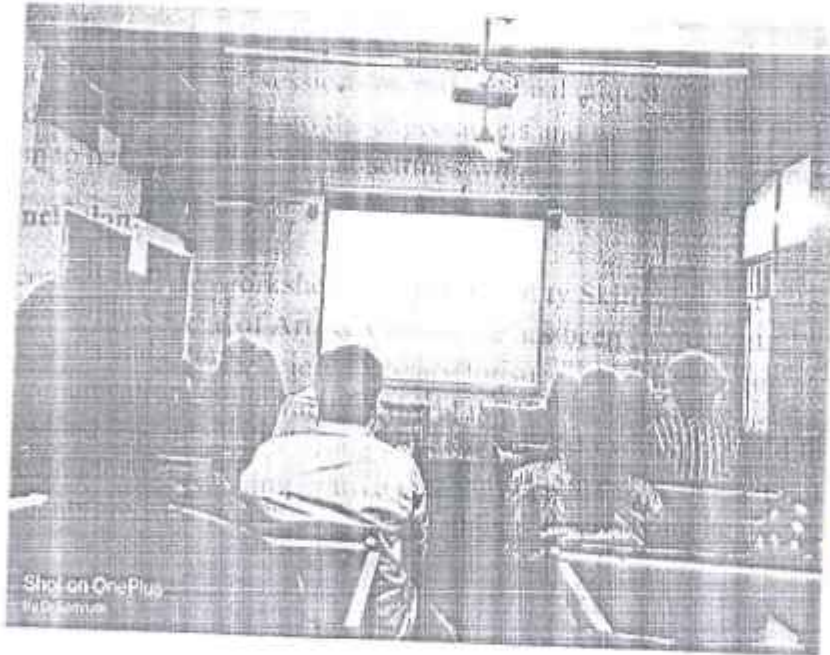
ability to tackle problems methodically, think creatively, and be adaptable - essential skills for today's ever-changing job market.

Report on 5th International Yoga Day

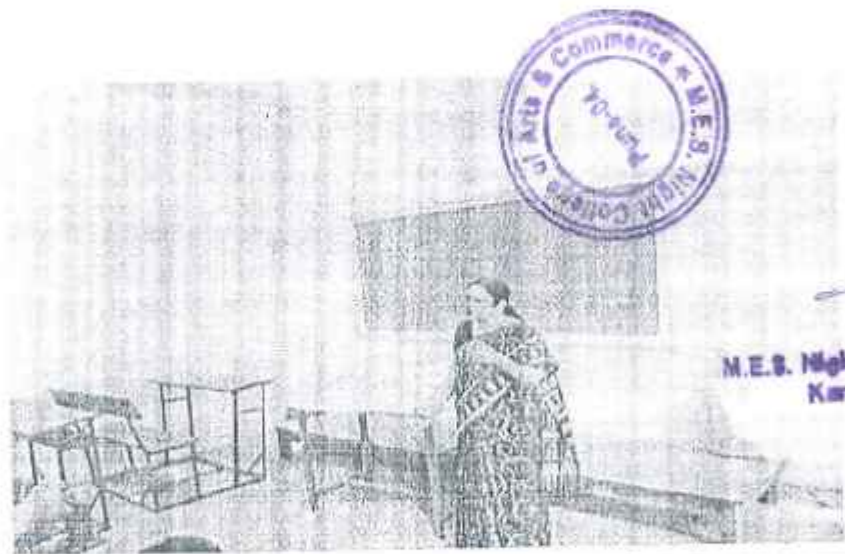

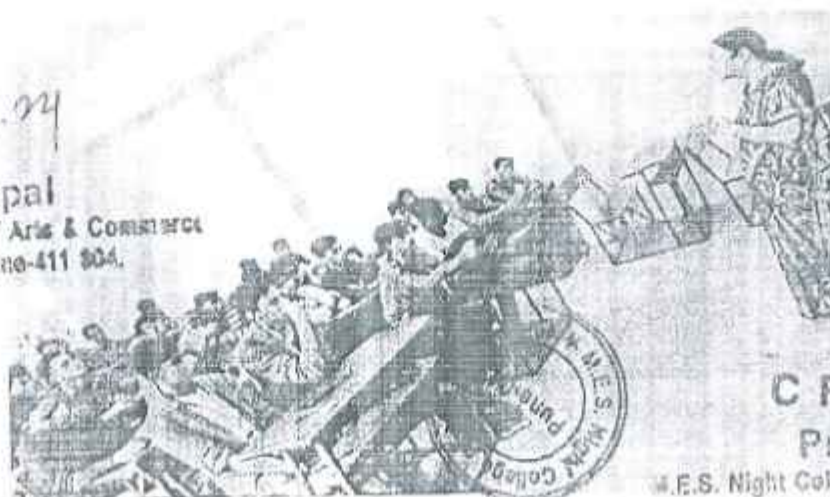
