



LIBMAN OPAC Awareness Program

MES Night College of Arts and Commerce successfully organized an online LIBMAN OPAC Awareness Program for students on 26th September 2024, conducted via Google Meet from 5:30 PM. The program was under the guidance of Principal Dr. Sujata Adamuthe led by Librarian Smita Raut, who provided both a theoretical and practical introduction to the LIBMAN OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) system, essential for accessing the library's resources digitally.

Objective of the Program:

The primary objective of the program was to:

- Educate students on how to use the LIBMAN OPAC system efficiently.
- Familiarize students with the digital library interface for easier access to academic resources.
- Demonstrate how to search, locate, and reserve books through the OPAC system.
- Encourage the use of online tools to enhance research and academic performance.
- Promote the digitalization of library services, ensuring that students can access materials remotely.

Key Highlights of the Program:

1. Presentation:

Smita Raut started the session with a PowerPoint presentation, explaining the importance of OPAC in the modern academic environment. She highlighted its features, such as:

- User-friendly search options for locating books by title, author, and subject.
- Real-time access to the availability status of materials.
- Option to reserve and request books online.
- Ability to manage library accounts for students, including renewals and lending status.

2. Practical Demonstration:

After the presentation, Smita Raut conducted a live demonstration of the LIBMAN OPAC system, where she:

- Showed how to log into the OPAC system using credentials.
- Explained different ways to search for books and resources.
- Demonstrated how students can place holds and view book availability.
- Gave a brief introduction to library account management, focusing on renewals, dues, and loan periods.

3. Interactive Session:




Students were encouraged to participate actively, with many posing questions and trying out the system in real time. The session provided hands-on experience, ensuring students gained practical knowledge.

Step 1: Search this URL - [Library – MES Night College of Arts and Commerce \(mespune.in\)](http://nightcollege.mespune.in)

Step 5: You can use the following options

Option 1: Home Option 2: Issue
Option 3: Over Due Option 4: New Arrivals
Option 5: Demand Option 6: Requisition
Option 7: Transaction History

Step 2: Click on 'OPAC'
Select Your Institute Name (MES Night College of Arts and Commerce)

Step 6: Click on "Issue" Option
You can view your book transactions, including issuing and returning books.

Step 3 : Log in Borrower Login

Step 7: Click on the "Over Due" Option
The library will charge you a fine if you return the book late.

Step 4: Type the details of your book as per selected Catalogue type
(Title, Author, Publisher, Subject)

Step 8: Click on "Demand" Option
You can select your book and reserve it using the reservation facility.

Step 9: Click on the "Transaction History" Option
You can review your book transactions with the library.
