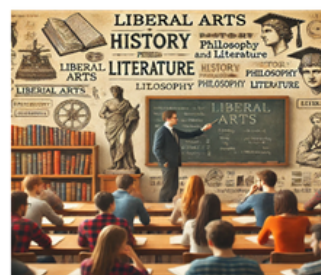

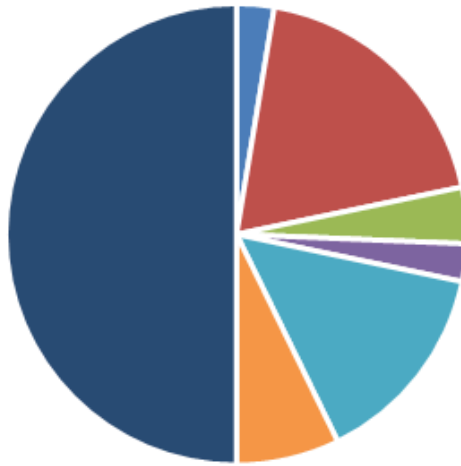

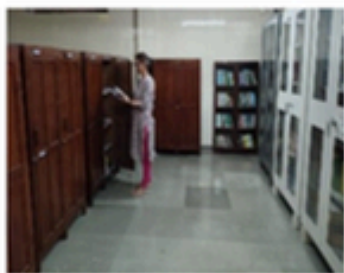

- **Library**

- **Reading Hall**

The spacious reading hall of MES Night College of Arts and Commerce is available for the students. The timings are 12.00 p.m. to 7.00 p.m.



- **A-V Hall**

Audio-Visual Hall is used for organizing guest lectures, events, etc.



- **Play-Ground**

College grounds are always engaged with various sports events like Archery, volleyball, Basketball, Kabaddi, Football, etc. Open gymnasium facility is available in the college for college students.



- **Canteen**

A canteen facility is available for students on the college campus. Mischievous behavior in the canteen will not be tolerated and any such incident will be dealt with strictly.



- **Vehicle Stand**

The Sufficient place is available of park cycle & two wheelers at campus.



- **Hostels**

Girls and boys can get accommodation in the separate buildings of the hostel located on the College campus. Detailed information & rules & regulations of the MES Hostel are available in the hostel handbook. Admissions to hostels are given strictly on a merit basis.

Code of Conduct (Discipline & Rules)

- 1. Students must attend lectures, practicals, tests, and exams regularly and at the appointed time. They should not remain absent without seeking the prior permission of the authorities. 75% attendance for all the subjects is mandatory. If the attendance of the student is not satisfactory, he/she will not be allowed to appear for the final examination. In such a case, the Principal's decision will be final.**
- 2. Students must take due care of the property of the college. They are expected to maintain the entire area clean & tidy.**
- 3. Students should not form any 'group' or 'forum' on the campus without seeking prior permission from the Principal in writing**
- 4. Students should not invite any person to organize a meeting without the prior permission of the authorities.**
- 5. Smoking, drinking, spitting, consuming drugs, chewing, and consuming tobacco in the College campus is strictly prohibited.**
- 6. Students should observe proper dressing sense in the college premises, which is generally acceptable to the society at large. It should be decent and dignified.**
- 7. Each student will get an Identity Card. A student must wear this card on the college Campus. It must be produced on demand by the College authorities. If a student is unable to produce the I-card he/she may be penalized by the College authorities.**
- 8. On the loss of I-Card, a student should seek duplicate card immediately from the college authorities by paying the necessary fees and fine.**
- 9. All the students must park their vehicles in the cycle /scooter stand.**
- 10. Authorities have full right to modify the rules whenever necessary, and following of such modified rules is obligatory for the students. In case of any dispute, Principal's decision will be final.**
- 11. College will take stern steps against the students in case of undisciplined behavior, disobeying of rules, and orders. In such a case, the Principal's decision will be final.**
- 12. Students should note that college authorities will not allow celebration of rose day, traditional day or any other similar events on the college campus.**
- 13. It is expected that all the college students should observe proper manners & discipline inside & outside the college premises.**
- 14. All the students should strictly follow the rules and instructions of the University of Pune, H.S.C. Board, and Director of Education & College Authorities.**
- 15. Students should be meticulous about filling the examination and eligibility forms on or before the stipulated date declared. In case of failure to fill these forms, the student himself/herself will be solely held responsible and will have to bear the consequences.**

16. Those who want to apply for different free ships & scholarships must apply within the prescribed time limit.

17. Student must be aware of provisions of section 95, Ordinance No. 157 of Maharashtra University Act regarding maintenance of good conduct and discipline by a student.

18. A student is likely to be punished or debarred from appearing in the University examination, if he/she misbehaves at the time of the examination

19. Ragging is a criminal offence. A student found guilty of ragging will be severely punished. Student will be expelled from the college and or hostel, & will have to under 90 legal proceedings as per UGC Regulation: No F 1 - 10 /2007 (CCP -11) April 2009.

Notice : All the concerned students and parents should note “ If any incidence of ragging comes to the notice of the authorities, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain himself/herself and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the college authorities would expel him/her from the college,” as per the order of the Hon’ble Supreme Court of India; and the Savitribai Phule Pune University letter reference no.CA/ 2283 dtd. 27th March 2008 and UGC Regulation no. F1-16/2007 (CPP-11) - April 2009
